The Common Enemy - Adolf Hitler

Breaking the Fine Line


After their pact, Josef Stalin, the leader of the Soviet Union, started to spread communist propaganda across non-Soviet countries; resulting in eventually breaking the fine line between America and the U.S.S.R*.

As former British Prime Minister Winston Churchill, stated: an "iron curtain" was created. It was a border between east and western Europe. The American government figured they could not stop communism, they could only contain it. This resulted in the figurative "iron curtain".


Physical Combat- Vietnam and Cuba
