








How do you think Sir Gorrell is feeling in this moment? What makes you think that?

"Me too," responded Aristar, "I find the flames too hot! I hate the fact that dragons have to breathe them such a lot.


If only we weren't enemies, we wouldn't need to fight And maybe, if we worked together, things would be all right."





What do you think an enemy is?








What kind of show do you think Sir Gorrell and Aristar are planning?

The message in the sky said:









How does Aristar describe Sir Gorrell?













